

### In-Text Citations

Include the last name(s) of the source's author or authors, the year of publication, and the page number(s) when available. Examples:

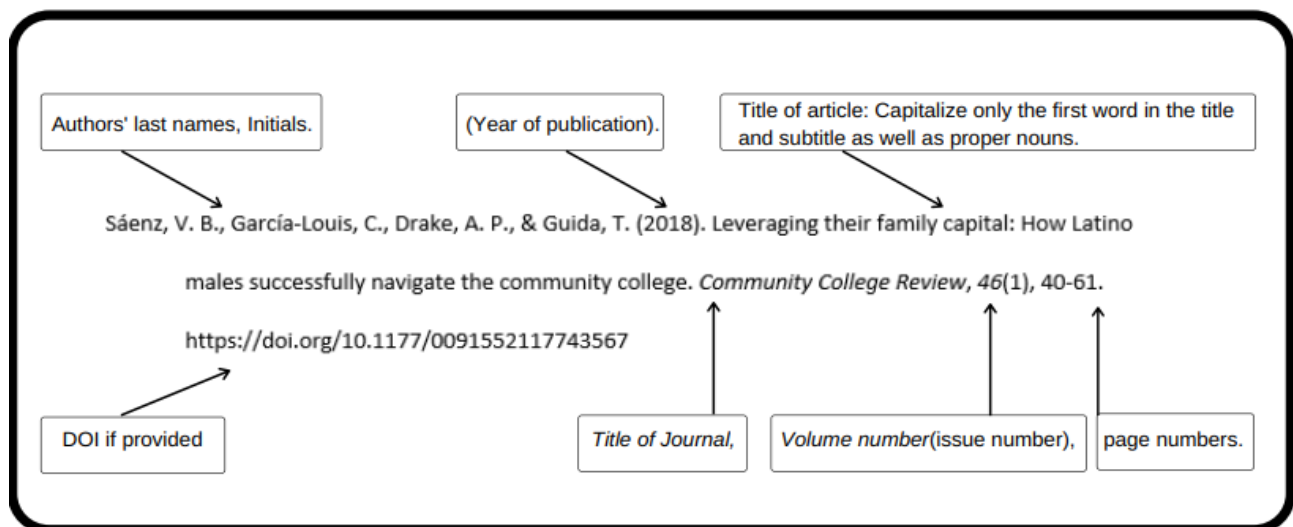
According to Garcia and Okhidoi (2015), college administrators “must stand behind programs that have historically served underrepresented students” (p. 353).

College administrators should support programs which have an established record of serving underrepresented students (Garcia & Okhidoi, 2015, p. 353).

### Citation Format for Articles

#### Journal Article from a Database

Author's Last Name, First initial. (Year). Article title: Capitalize only the first word in the title and subtitle. *Title of Publication, volume(issue)*, page numbers. DOI if provided



#### Newspaper Article

Author's Last Name, First initial. (Year, Month Day). Article title: Capitalize only the first word in the title and subtitle. *Title of Publication*, page numbers. DOI or web address of article

#### Magazine Article

Author's Last Name, First initial. (Year, Month Day). Article title: Capitalize only the first word in the title and subtitle. *Title of Publication, volume(issue)*, page numbers. DOI or web address of article

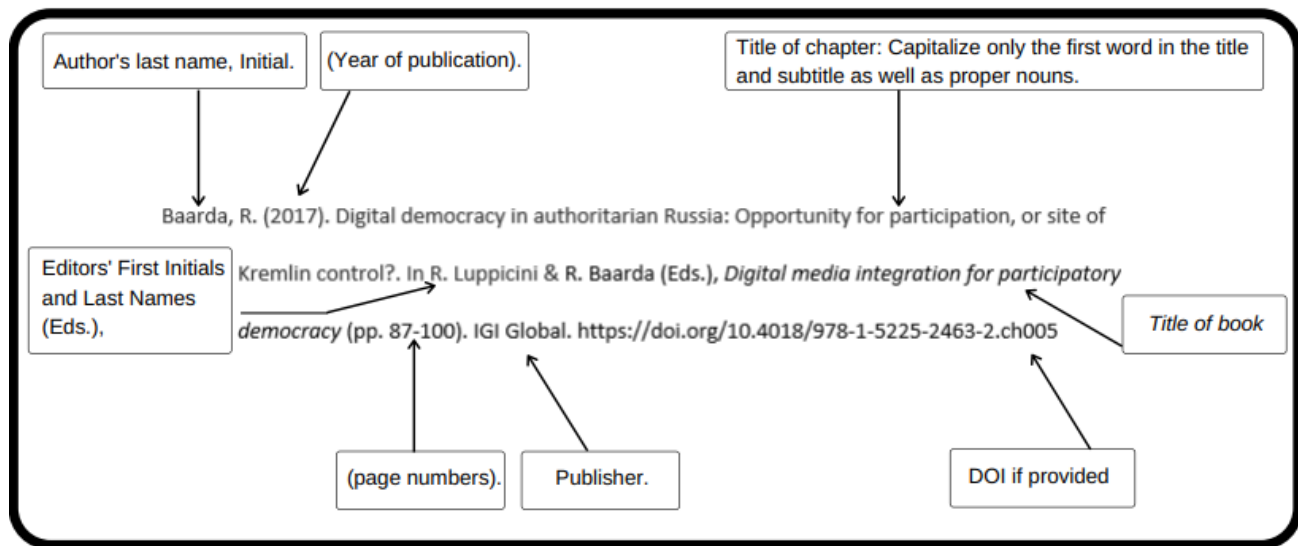
## Citation Format for Books

### Entire Book

Author's Last Name, First initial. (Year). *Title of book: Capitalize only the first word in the title and subtitle.* Publisher.

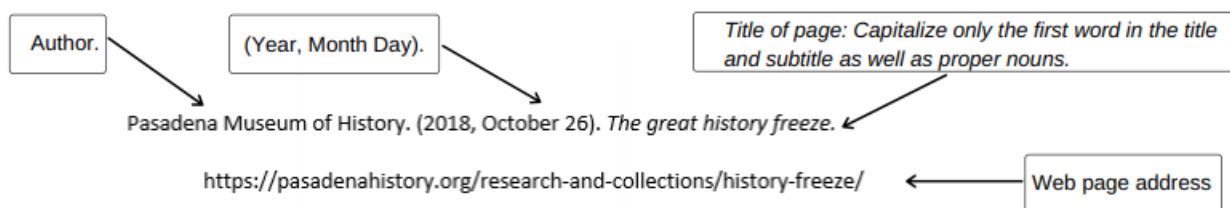
### Chapter in an ebook

Author's Last Name, First Initial. (Year). Title of chapter. In E.E. Editor and F.F. Editor (Eds.), *Title of book* (page numbers). Publisher. DOI if provided



## Citation Format for Web Pages

Author's Last Name, First initial. (Year, Month Day). *Page title: Capitalize only the first word in the title and subtitle.* Site name if different from author name. Web page address



### Pro Tips:

- Title the page References. Center the title.
- Double space throughout.
- Begin each citation at left margin. Use a *hanging indent* (0.5 inch from left margin) for all subsequent lines.
- Order citations alphabetically.
- Include all authors up to and including twenty. Example: Garrod, A., Kilkenny, R., Benson, M., & Prince, S.
- Use Times New Roman 11, Calibri 11, Arial 11, Lucina Sans Unicode 10, Georgia 11, or Computer Modern 10.
- If DOI is available for any online source type, include it at the end of the citation formatted as follows:
